**RULES & REGULATIONS - Part 5**  
**POOL RULES**

**GENERAL RULES**

1. There are no lifeguards. All pool users do so at their own risk and are advised never to swim alone.
2. Opening and closing date for the pool will depend upon weather. Regular pool hours are from dawn until dusk. The locks on the pool have the same combination as the entrance to the clubhouse. Early swimmers may have to work around the schedule of the pool operator.
3. Showers are available in the lower level of the clubhouse. A cleansing shower before entering the pool is required by law.
4. Anyone with a communicable disease, skin, eye, ear or nasal infections, or open sores is prohibited from using the pool.
5. Spitting, spouting of water, or blowing of the nose in the pool is prohibited. No diapers in the pool.
6. **Not permitted**: boisterous play, running, pushing, diving, or projectile-like water entries.
7. Animals of any kind are not permitted inside the pool enclosure.
8. No glass containers are permitted inside the pool enclosure.
9. Only proper swimming suits are permitted. Cut-off trousers are not proper swim suits.
10. Persons less than 16 years old must be with a parent or a parent-designated adult.
11. Rafts, inner tubes, and floats (except lifesaving or training devices) are not permitted when the pool is crowded - please be considerate of others.
12. Harmful objects (i.e. rocks, dirt, furniture, cans, etc.) will not be thrown into the pool.
13. Playing of loud music is prohibited.
14. All pool users must remove their trash on leaving the pool.
15. Smoking or other tobacco use is not allowed inside the pool enclosure.
16. The pool is **not** available for private parties.
17. Please place a towel on the chairs when using suntan lotion. After sun bathing, please shower before entering the pool.
18. When leaving the pool area, please:
  - Close table umbrellas.
  - Return chairs to their original places & positions.
  - Take your refuse with you.
  - Turn off all lights in the lower level of the clubhouse.
  - Be sure the door to the lower level is locked and the key is returned to its proper place.

- Close and **lock** all gates if no other swimmers are present.
19. Reminder: Please do **not** go through the clubhouse to enter or leave the pool area.
  20. Emergency procedures are posted by the clubhouse door.

## **POOL USE BY GUESTS**

1. Guests of residents are welcome to use the pool; **however**, residents are responsible for making sure their houseguests are informed of and abide by **all** the pool rules.
2. A resident must accompany local guests who wish to use the pool. Non-local houseguests and family members of residents *do not* need to be accompanied by a resident. Residents are responsible for making sure their guests abide by all pool rules.
3. Guests are required to sign in on the bulletin board at the pool.
4. At no time may a guest or resident under 16 be at the pool without the host or an adult houseguest. The host is requested to introduce guests to other swimmers present.
5. Children of members who are 16 or older, may bring a maximum of **two (2)** guests to the pool or pool area. Children under 16 are not allowed to bring guests without being accompanied by their parent or designated adult.
6. The number of guests on weekends and holidays is limited to six (6) houseguests or four (4) local guests per household. Local guests are limited to four (4) visits per month. The Pool Committee must approve exceptions to these limits for special occasions such as family reunions or special family celebrations in advance.
7. Since there is no lifeguard or other supervision, it becomes the responsibility of each adult at the pool to monitor compliance with these rules, especially those applying to the behavior of children and the presence of unaccompanied guests.

**THE POOL AREA, DUE TO ITS POPULARITY AND USE BY ALL AGES, IS OF CONCERN TO ALL. INFRACTIONS OF THESE RULES MAY LEAD TO LOSS OF POOL PRIVILEGES.**

These Rules & Regulations supersede all other such Rules & Regulations governing use of the Pool. These **Pool Rules**, which are **Rules and Regulations Part 5** of the DVCA, have been adopted and approved by the Board of Directors this 19th day of April 2011.
